

INTRODUCTORY KNOWLEDGE OF NUMBERS

- **1. Natural Numbers (N)** Also called positive integers, counting number; they are numbers starting from one. {1, 2, 3, 4, 5,}
- **2.** Whole Numbers (W) This is the set of natural numbers, plus zero, i.e., {0, 1, 2, 3, 4,5...}
- 4. Fractional number- It is used to represent a part of a whole. Fractions consist of two numbers: a numerator (which is above the line) and a denominator (which is below the line).

 or. The denominator tells you the number of equal parts into which something is divided
- **5. Decimal number** It is defined as a number whose whole number part and the fractional part is separated by a decimal point.
- **6. Even number** It is a number that can be divided into two equal groups. Even numbers end in 2, 4, 6, 8 and 0.
- **7.** An odd number- It is a number that cannot be divided into two equal groups. Odd numbers end in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9.
- **8. Prime number-** A number that can be divided exactly by itself only and 1 for example 5 7, 11, 13 and 19.

CONCEPT OF LEAP YEAR.

- A year containing an extra day. It has 366 days instead of the normal 365 days.
 The extra day is added in February, which has 29 days instead of the normal 28 days.
- Leap years occur every 4 years. 2020 is a leap year and so is 2024.



ANTONYMS are words with opposite meanings.

Examples: Good \times Bad, Fat \times Thin

SYNONYMS are words with the same or similar meaning.

Examples: Good - fine, great.

Hot: - burning, boling

HOMONYMS are words that are spelled and pronounced the same, but have different meanings.

Example: Right, Write. Left (verb), Left (noun)

NOUN - (naming word) A noun is the name of a person, place, thing or idea.

Examples: Ram, London, table, dog, teacher, pen, city, happiness, hope.

PRONOUN - (replaces a noun) A pronoun is used in place of a noun or noun phrase to avoid repetition. **Examples**: I, you, we, they, he, she, it, me, us, them, him, her, this, those.

ADJECTIVE-(describing word) It describes, modifies or gives more information about a noun or pronoun.

Examples: big, happy, green, young, fun, crazy, three.

VERB - (action word) A verb shows an action or state of being. A verb shows what someone or something is doing. **Examples**: go, speak, run, eat, play, live, walk, have, like, is, are etc.
